Job requirements include: Before a candidate applies they should have clear criminal records check and if you are 18 years old, a vulnerable sector, must be included, a completed 1^{st} aid course, and an up-to-date immunization record which must include a TB test, Hep B series and an up-to-date Tetanus.

Job description: Some of the duties required of the junior leader includes but are not limited to; complying with all YWCA NWT policies and procedures, helping the senior leader ensure the safety of the children in the programs, playing with the children, assisting with monthly fire drills, ensuring the program location and equipment are cleaned regularly and in good repair, provides minor 1st aid to the children as needed, assisting the children by promoting and demonstrating positive and friendly choices and reports any and all concerns or injuries to the senior leader.

Rate of pay is \$17/hr.
